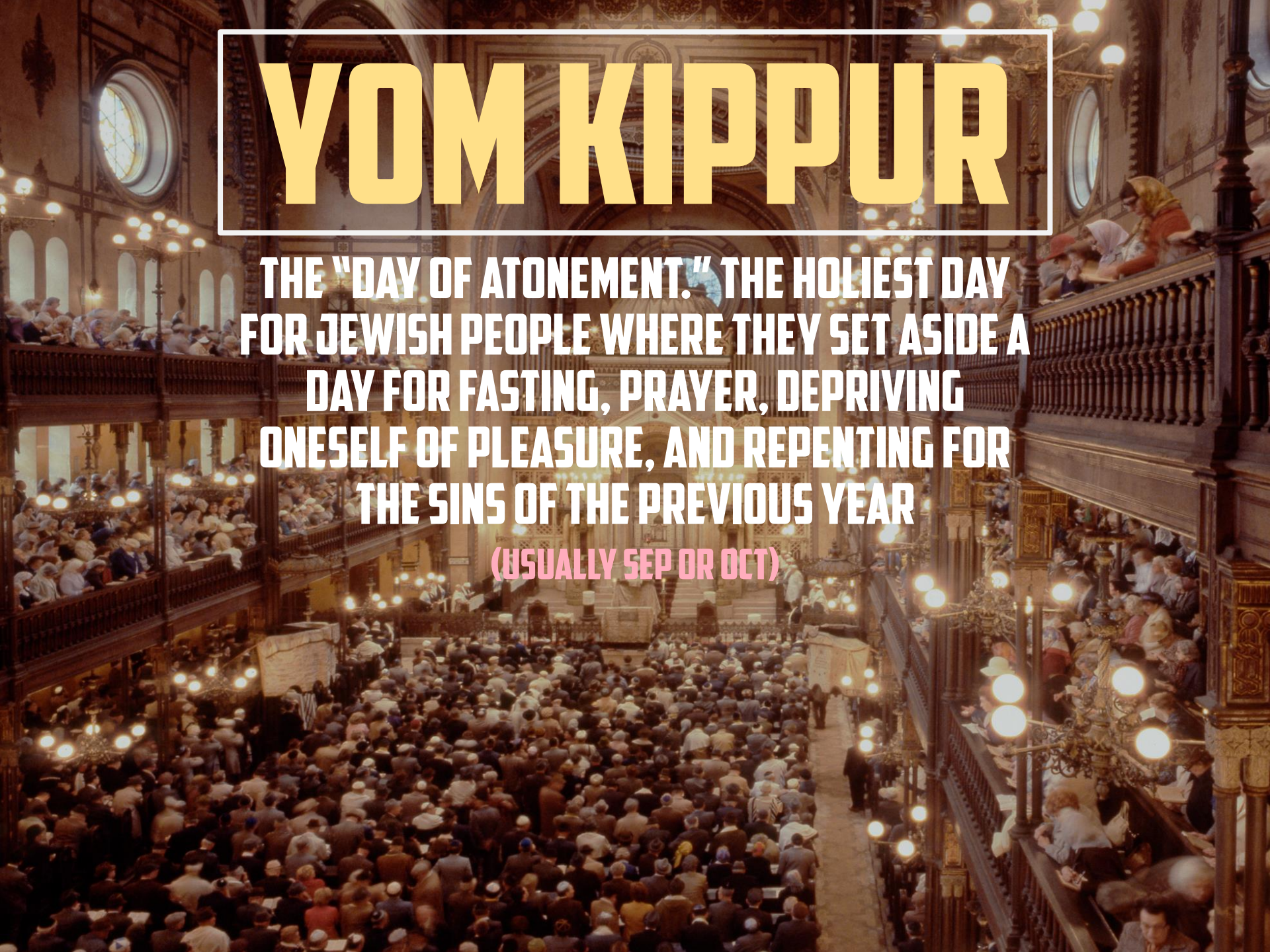




YOM KIPPUR

(lamb shank bone)

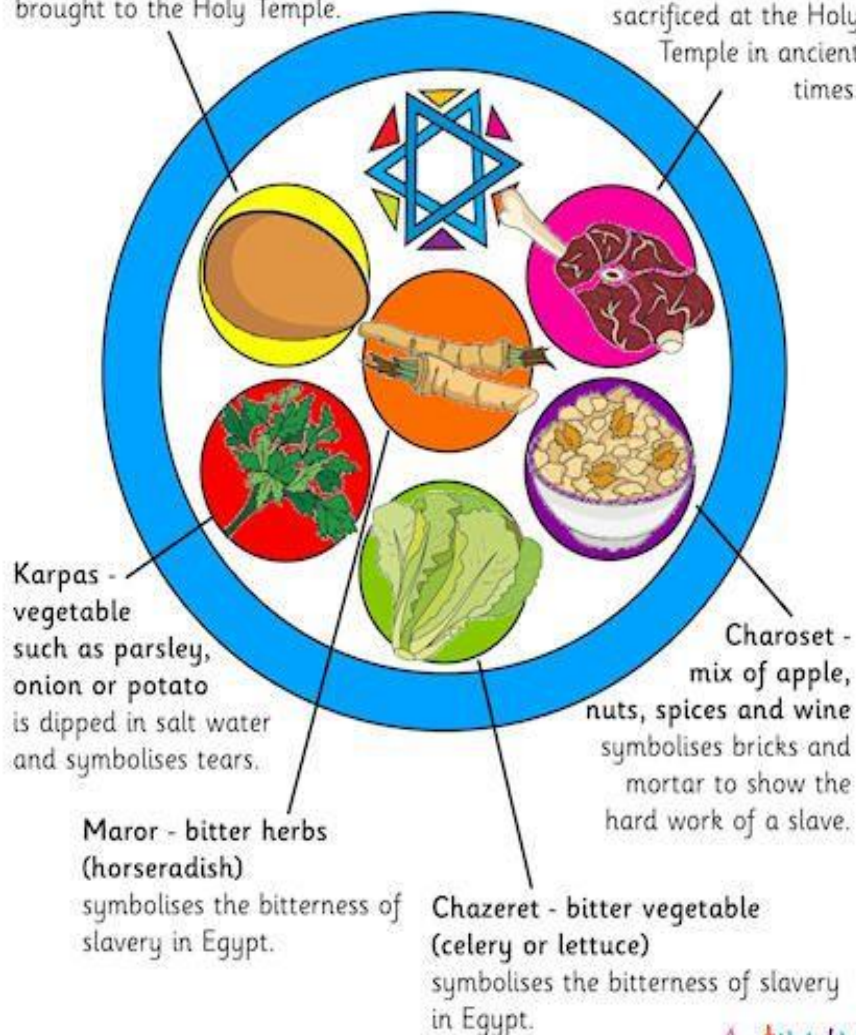


Beitzah
